

CD5031 Programming using Matrix[®] **Configurator Software**

IMPORTANT! Read all instructions before installing and using. Installer: This manual must be delivered to the end user.

When programming the CD5031 with either a SWITCHNODE or a Z3S siren, please be aware of a possible issue involving certain flash patterns.

The Flash Pattern matrix in Table 1 shows the flash patterns that should operate correctly when used with the CD5031.

Note: The Alternating function, see Figures 1 & 2, can cause unexpected flash pattern behavior when used with the CD5031.
